Once we have taken your item/s into our care, they are fully insured with us and will be catalogued, photographed, processed and safely stored ready for our auction.

Will photos of my items be in the auction catalogue?

Although not every single lot is guaranteed to get its photo into the catalogue, we can assure you that all lots are shot in-house by our team of professional photographers with the same care and attention to detail and will be viewable on our website and on the live Global auction platforms we use.

I haven't heard back from you since consigning my item/s. Should I be concerned?

Don't worry. Unless there has been a specific reason for correspondence, you won't hear from us until about three weeks prior to auction at which point you will receive a copy of our full colour catalogue along with an A4 sheet listing your consigned item/s with their corresponding lot no.s, estimates and reserves.

Please read through your contract (on the reverse of your consignment form) in your own time once you've consigned. The contract gives you important information regarding the sale (or non-sale) of your items and will answer lots of questions you may still have.
