Total prices realised: £470,827 (incl. prem.)

A magnificent result, driven by high demand for gold, silver, portable valuables and assets. Antique jewellery in particular is attracting fiercely competitive bidding; for example lot 348: Victorian 18ct gold, coral and pearl pendant; top est. £700, hammer £2100.

Vintage and luxury watches as usual performed strongly. Rolexes reached up to £11,600 for a "Pepsi" GMT 1968. Pocket watches were also strong, especially heavy gold cased ones, which were selling well-over estimate, and miles above bullion in most cases.

The Silver section featured many highlights including an Irish tankard at £3800, a Comyns & Sons modern centrepiece 1970 at £2100, and a Christopher Dresser spoon warmer at £1450.
