Total prices realised: £72,973 (incl. prem.)

Aboriginal and ethnographic art performed well throughout the sale, in addition paintings sold included a Manchester oil by Arthur Delaney for £4200, and the works by Jeff Keen – 'ZAP' and 'KZAT' made £3000 apiece.

The always popular Toys and Models brought notable results for an Austin pedal car (£900), an Action Man Commander (£160), a group of dolls in at £50 (£1000 ! incl. Simba/Palitoy), Star Wars groups up to £340, and solid interest in boxed Corgi. The Model Railway section sold well universally.

Among the Ceramics & Glass we noted £210 for a Meissen figure, and £1200 for a Whitefriars tangerine 'banjo' vase.

The Books & Ephemera contained an interesting album of photographs from Gilbert H.F. Vane's travels in Egypt and Europe c.1887, which sold for £580. A group of film posters and lobby cards including 'The African Queen' achieved £850.

In the Musical Instruments we sold a concertina for £1000, and a harp for £1150. In Scientific a McFarlane's Cylinder for £460; and in misc. Antiques & Collectables – boxes of cigars up to £850, and a set of Dupont lighters for £1300.
