

Lockdales' Auction #212 Report: The Banknote Sale 19-20 February 2022

Total prices realised: £155,300 (including premium)

979 lots were offered, with a success rate of 83%.

Another solid banknote auction, with demand especially for UK, Commonwealth and Irish notes. Strong prices were seen for “white notes”, up to £2300 hammer for a Manchester branch £10. The highest price of the sale was £5600 for the Indian One Rupee 1917, lot 699.
