Lockdales' Auction #220 Report: The Banknote Sale: 6-7 August 2022

Total prices realised: £161,913 (incl. prem.)

Once again English, Scottish, British Empire & Commonwealth notes performed strongly, as well as those of China, Hong Kong, India, Malaysia, and Arab states. Standout prices included £950 hammer for a last run Bradbury 10/- 1915 PMG 65 EPQ; £1600 for a Scotland, Commercial Bank £100 1951 aVF; £1700 for a China 100 Yuan Fed. Res. Bank Pick# J59 PMG 63 EPQ; and £1800 for a Hong Kong \$50 1930 aVF, to mention a few. There was a particularly strong series of Scottish notes in the sale which were very well received, the majority of results being above estimate.

Our next Banknote Sale is scheduled for 3-4 December, with consignment currently open until 28th October – should be pretty big sale by then!
