The Banknote Sale: 29-30 November 2023

Total prices realised: £141,444 (incl. prem.)

In the English sections the most popular notes proved to be the 'white notes' such as a Liverpool £100 1936 at £1250; as well as the 'firsts and lasts', consecutives, and unusual serials such as '666666' and more. Other strong results included Hong Kong, Iraq and Malaya notes, the highest price being £3200 hammer for a "boy king" Iraq ¼ Dinar PMG 63 EPQ. The bulk lots and collections, both British and World, were highly sought-after.
