## Online Auction #190 Report: The Banknote Sale, 28th November 2020

626 lots offered; total sales £84,330. Standout lots included printers plates selling for up to £600 hammer. The biggest surprise was lot 309: India One Rupee, Gubbay signed 1917, D/91 359203, F-GF. Estimated at £100 to £150, the hammer went down at £10,400! Multiple online and phone bidders from India took part. A rare variety, yet unknown to UK dealers it seems. Another similar note B/1 017069 in better grade went for £260!

Strong demand was noted for Malaysian (Malaya/Straits/Borneo) notes. Scottish notes maintain a healthy rate of sales. Bulk lots and collections were the most popular in general due to the number of online sellers hunting for stock. One World lot estimated £700 to £800 made £2900.
