

Lockdales' Auction #235 Report:

The Fine Sale (jewellery, watches, silver, vertu): 25-26 April 2023

Total prices realised: £412,450 (incl. prem.)

This large offering of jewellery, watches and silver was well-received. Above all interest was in items of vintage and antique jewellery, which were making well-above estimate. Lot 107, an Art Deco platinum diamond ring went for £9500 (est. £4500-£5500). Butterscotch amber necklaces are extremely popular, selling for up to £1350 (est. £200). Gold-cased pocket watches are making well-above bullion indicating a growing market for antique timepieces. Indian and Chinese silver objects are attracting fierce bidding. A rose-water sprinkler in at £140 made £1000 for example.
