

Lockdales' Auction #215 Report: The Banknote Sale 7-8 May 2022

Total prices realised: £121,103 (including premium)

Good demand was seen for England, Scotland, Ireland, Commonwealth, Indian and Malaysian material (Straits, Sarawak, Borneo). The highest price of the sale being £3200 hammer for a GB One Rupee, lot 607, which was another scarce variety of this strong series. A Cameroun 5000 Francs 1962 made £1800 hammer (top est. £1200) showing continued demand for large denomination French colonial notes. Falkland Isles and Rhodesia were highly sought-after, indicating confidence in British notes overall.
