Antiques & Collectables Sale: 3rd May 2023

Total prices realised: £65,466 (incl. prem.)

445 lots were offered, and 410 sold, giving a success rate of 92%. This was a popular sale, with high attendance in the room, and many sections with increased interest. We began with a section of Clocks, where a Heuer dashboard clock made £650; followed by the Picture section with prices up to £3800 – for the unique "Giles" original artwork relating to Christine Keeler and the Profumo Affair. The Ceramics section was remarkably strong, with fierce bidding on Coalport, Royal Crown Derby, Royal Worcester and others. On the topic of coronations, lot 90 – the Eric Ravilious, Wedgwood QEII Coronation mug made £520 (!) against a top estimate of just £80. The Toys and Models were popular as always, with barely any unsolds. It was a bumper sale for model rail enthusiasts. Other highlights included Chinese interest such as a pair of silk shoes which sold for £1200.
